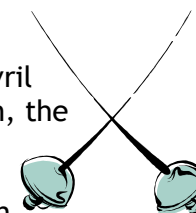


En garde!

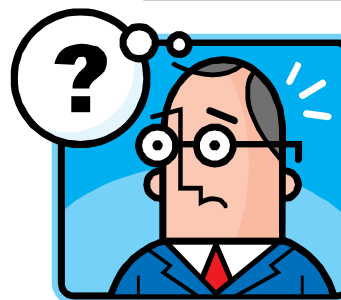
Carol Service Cancelled
