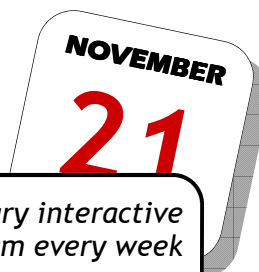

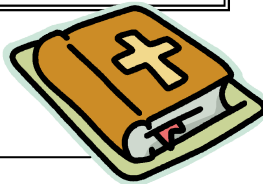
Further Prayer Opportunities
