From Sunday February 6th, coffee will be served in the Coffee Centre from 6:00pm. The service will begin as usual at 6:30pm

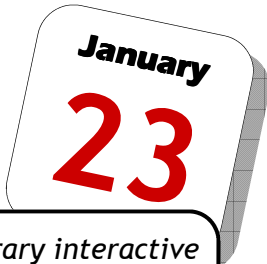

Our Prayer Table at the entrance to the Sanctuary offers helpful leaflets for private prayer.

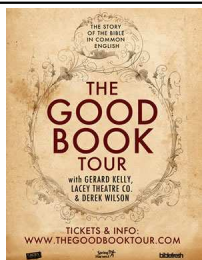
