



### Harvest Festival Appeal

This year's Harvest Festival will take place on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> September when Christchurch will aim to support the work of the Methodist Relief and Development Fund (MRDF) in Uganda. In particular, MRDF runs a partner group called RUHEPAL that promotes access to tools and training amongst farmers in order to enhance crop yield.
