The **Red Book** in the foyer is always available for written prayer requests.

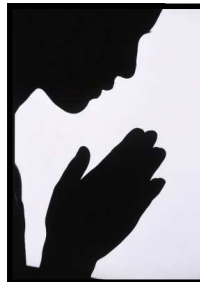
