Have you got a spare cupboard?

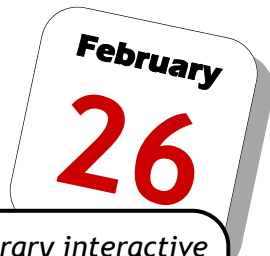
