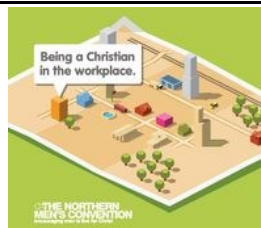

IN 2012**

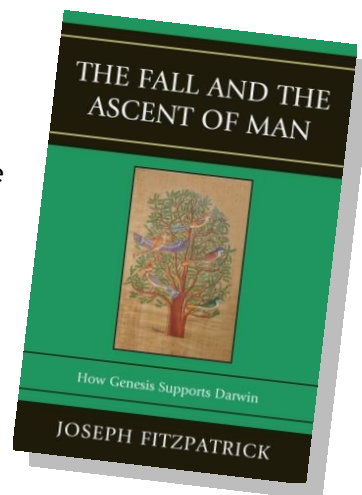
