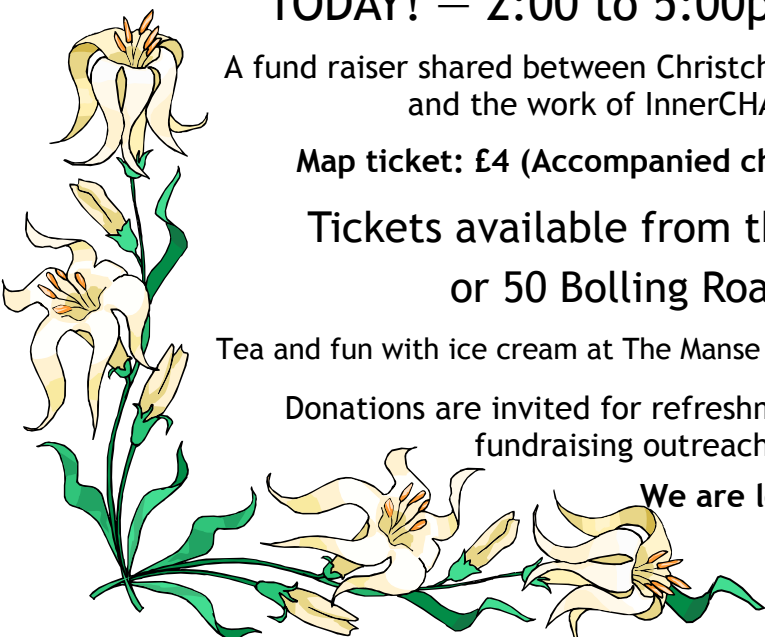

Worship Consultation - Wednesday 18th July at 7:30pm

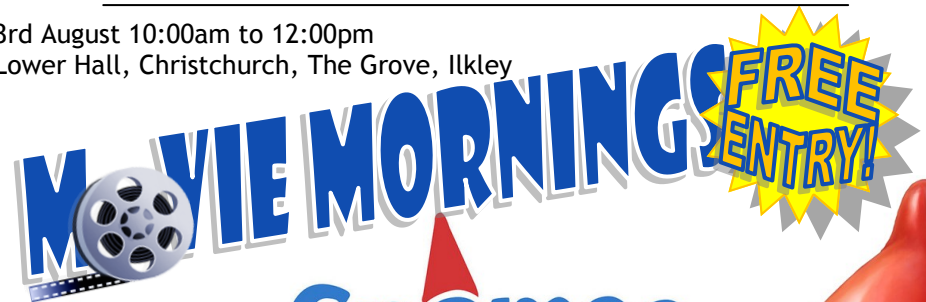
