
Jigfest 2014 - We are still collecting jigsaws for this event, please drop in any jigsaws to the office (please ensure they are complete).

Is Faith Delusion? Churches Together in Ilkley have invited Professor Andrew Sims to talk on the subject of his book 'Is Faith Delusion?: Why religion is good for your health' on Tuesday 7th May at Ilkley Baptist Church, Kings Road at 8pm.

Professor Sims was Professor of Psychiatry in the University of Leeds and a past President of the Royal College of Psychiatrists. He has served on the General Medical Council and is author of 12 books.



The talk follows the CTI AGM at 7.15pm and will be followed by refreshments and the opportunity to chat about issues raised.
