17th September - A Day with Fr. Daniel O'Leary: 'A Journey into yourself'
'My deepest Me is God', sang St. Catherine of Genoa. Begin with the heart, it will lead you to God.

16th October - A Day with Margaret Silf: "The Other Side of Chaos"
