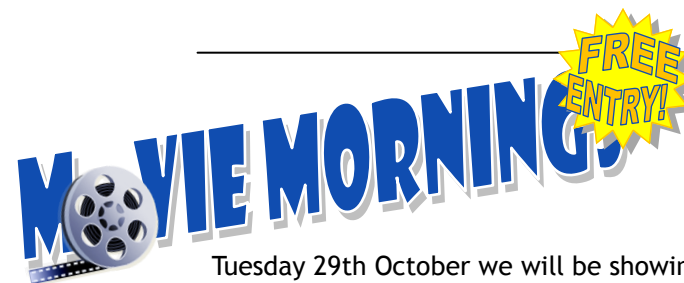
An extra treat:

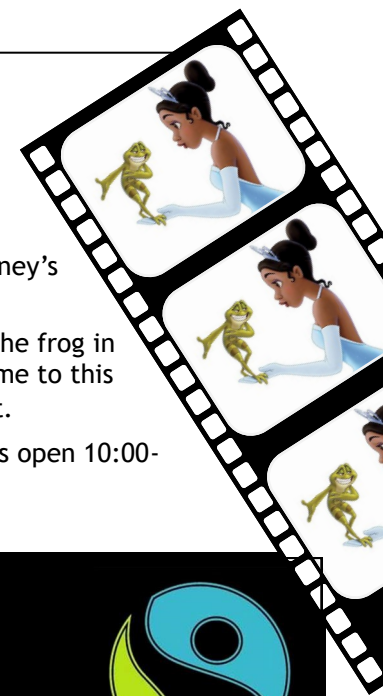
