In remembrance of those men, and, their hopes for the Peace to come, there will be a football match on the 10th November in Bradford's Centenary Square, 1:30pm to 4:00pm.

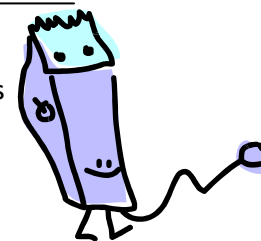
Calling all Small Group and Housegroup leaders!
