9:30am - 10:00am in the Fellowship Room, a time of shared prayer open to all.

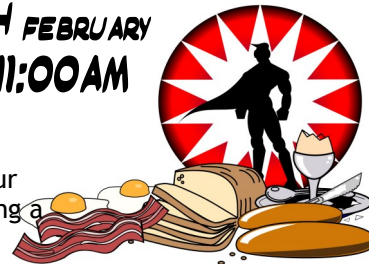
Our Prayer Table at the entrance to the Sanctuary offers helpful leaflets for private prayer.

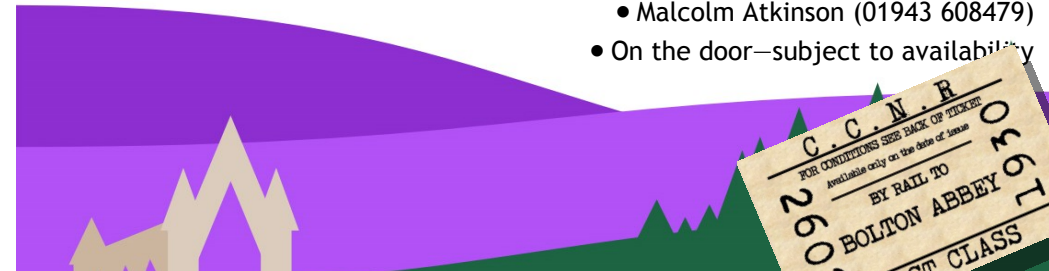
