

**Cycle for Syria** - Churches Together Challenge to raise £2,000 for Save the Children's appeal for Syrian citizens and refugees. Yorkshire is about 2000 miles from Syria, so this will be a challenge for Ilkley to look beyond the town to an area of need in the world. Each church has taken on the challenge for a week before the Tour De France starts and aim to cycle a minimum of 250 miles and raise a minimum of £250 per church. From Sunday 22nd June two exercise bikes will be sited in Christchurch foyer (or outside the doors!) for visitors to cycle and a bucket for collections in the Cafe. It will give opportunity for all Christchurch visitors to participate.
