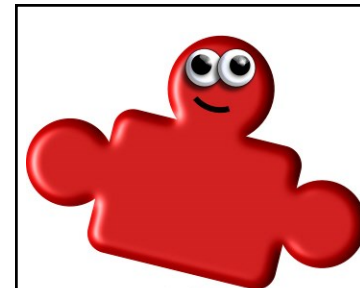
- taking minutes
