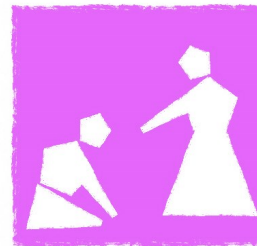

8:00pm — At Christchurch - Rev Rob Hilton will introduce us to the reflections of the nuns of Turvey Abbey.



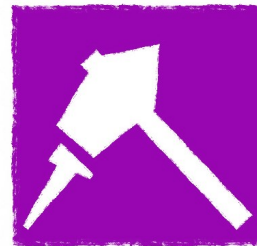
Tuesday March 31st
