'Stewardship 2015/16

At the recent Congregational Meeting, Tom Collins, Church Treasurer, reported that pledged giving to Christchurch had not changed for the last 3 years. There is a predicted deficit of £18,500 for the coming year.

It is possible to cover this if we are all able to increase giving by 15% or £2 per week. Knowing the pledged financial support for the year enables Christchurch to plan ahead with confidence, so far only 20 have replied to the request for information on giving for the coming year.
